 **iStream** The League is an international organization specifically committed to improving community colleges through innovation, experimentation, and institutional transformation. Colleges connect with the League by joining the [League Alliance](#) and subscribing to iStream, an online service that streams engaging video, radio, print, and other interactive resources.

CTL would like to ensure that all of our two-year colleges (and any interested universities) have access to the iStream subscription service and its tremendous professional development resources.

**The Deal, 2007-2008:** A trial period has been established to begin October 15, for the next 7 months. During that time you will have the opportunity to login to iStream at no cost and evaluate how it can help you with your faculty development programming. In addition, there are many resources in iStream that inform administrators.

Login information will be provided via the CTL Web site. Faculty and administrators will set up an account with name and e-mail address.

At the Leaders Spring Workshop, we will conduct a survey to see how useful it has been and will ask you if your campus is interested in signing up for the discounted service next year (July 1, 2008 – June 30, 2009).

**The Deal, 2008-2009:** Attached you will find the pricing information for next year. These numbers and savings are based on systemwide participation. If there are institutions who do not participate, then the total will be divided proportionately, and a significant savings can still be realized. In April, we are going to ask you (and your chief academic officer)...Deal or No Deal?
